On Sunday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday mornings, **פרק ק"ב** and **קכ"א** should be said after Shacharis.
On Monday and Wednesday, the **שיר של יום** should be said Pasuk by Pasuk. Between Mincha and Ma'ariv each day, **פרק ע"ט** should be said.
We will be saying Shomer Yisroel out loud line-by-line.
